
Sub: Award of compensatory marks.

In view of modified Board rules for Engineering Programmes as per notification as at Sr.No. 2 above, the award of compensatory marks for students under "**A category**" of Semester VI (03 years & 04 years Diploma Programmes) and Semester IV (Diploma Programme in Architectural Engg.), for the second term of academic year 2019-20 is as below:-

- 1) Marks scored by a student in any paper will be computed by counting marks awarded to Question No.1 and
- 2) From Q.Nos. 2 to 6, marks of the best four questions shall be counted and 'average marks of the best four questions (out of Q.Nos. 2 to 6)' shall be added, as marks for the remaining fifth question.

Further, in Courses where the question paper pattern is different from the above, an appropriate decision for award of compensatory marks, if any, will be taken on case to case basis.

Ref: Board Meeting dated 5th May 2020.


Board members in its Board meeting held on 5th May 2020 deliberated on the issue and approved the decision as below:-

Decision: 2.0 It was approved to have online Courses & Mini Projects/ Mega Project/Case studies as alternative training across various Diploma Programmes, as follows :-

- a) For Sandwich Diploma Programs having Full Semester training:
 - i) 01 Online Course & 02 Mini Projects OR
 - ii) 01 Online Course & 01 Mega Project
- b) For Non-Sandwich Diploma Programs having 08 weeks training:
01 Online Course & 01 Mini Project.

It shall be mandatory for such students to have satisfactorily attended online course, with progressive evaluation of the same.

- c) For Diploma Programme in Pharmacy:
Case Study reports of 1-2 pages each, on any 12 topics, out of approved list to topics.
